




The Little Prince

The narrator, an airplane pilot, crashes in the Sahara desert. As he is worrying about his predicament, he is approached by the little prince, a very serious little blond boy. The pilot learns that the little prince comes from a small planet called Asteroid 325 and that one day, a mysterious rose sprouted on the planet and the little prince fell in love with it. But when he caught the rose in a lie one day, he decided to leave and set out to explore other planets and cure his loneliness.

While journeying the little prince passes by neighboring asteroids and encountered the strange, narrow-minded world of grown-ups. However, he learns that flowers do not last forever, and he begins to miss the rose he has left behind.

The prince befriends a fox, who teaches him that the important things in life are visible only to the heart, that his time away from the rose makes the rose more special to him, and that love makes a person responsible for the beings that one loves. The little prince realizes that, even though there are many roses, his love for his rose makes her unique and that he is therefore responsible for her. Despite this revelation, he still feels very lonely because he is so far away from his rose. He realizes that too many people do not see what is truly important in life and he is fixed on returning to his rose.

About Acrobatic Dance


Acrobatic Dance, or acro as it is commonly referred to by dancers and dance professionals, is the beautiful fusion

of classic dance technique and the precision and athleticism of acrobatic elements. Often defined by unique choreography, acro dancers seamlessly blend musicality, emotional expression, line and extension with acrobatic movements in a dance context.

Acro is an especially challenging style for dancers to master, as training in both dance and acrobatic elements is required. Acro technique includes balancing, limbering, tumbling and partnering, based in flexibility, contortion and strength.

The Benefits

Dancers who train through Acrobatic Arts have balanced development, are stronger, more flexible and fearless. Studios that implement this program will see dancers with more skills, who have fewer accidents, and are less likely to develop chronic injuries.



Circus Arts / Aerial Dance

About Silks

Aerial silks (also known as aerial contortion, aerial ribbons, aerial silks, aerial tissues, fabric, ribbon, or tissu, depending on personal preference) is a type of performance in which one or more artists perform aerial acrobatics while hanging from a fabric. The fabric may be hung as two pieces, or a single piece, folded to make a loop, classified as hammock silks. Performers climb the suspended fabric without the use of safety lines, and rely only on their training and skill to ensure

safety. They use the fabric to wrap, suspend, fall, swing, and spiral their bodies into and out of various positions. Aerial silks may be used to fly through the air, striking poses and figures while flying. Aerial Dance is also categorized as an extreme sport.

About Bungee Dancing

Bungee Dance brings new possibilities and a new feeling of flying. Attached to a bungee sling students will jump fly and dance. Imagine being able to explore movement in an exhilarating feeling of defying gravity as a form of getting an intense full body workout. This high-intensity workshop/class has one floating weightlessly, dynamically bouncing and spinning freely into space.

About Vertical Dancing


Vertical Dance Expression is based on climbing the wall by utilizing gear harnesses, and ropes, to suspend the body in the air from a top anchor. The dancers create the illusion that gravity was being applied from the wall, rather than the ground. It takes an incredible amount of core strength and body awareness to have the correct alignment on the wall.

More recently, Acro and Aerial Dance gained popularity with the wide spread success of the contemporary circus productions of Cirque du Soleil. Main stream media including dance television programs like 'So You Think You Can Dance', 'America's Best Dance Crew' and 'Dance Moms', have further fuelled its demand in amateur competitive dance and studio settings.






