



# Invited Artist

Yahaira Natasha Maduro (n.1971, Aruba) is an autodidact visual artist, based in Aruba. Ever since she was a child she loved to draw and paint. Having obtained an LL.M in Notarial Law from Leiden University in the Netherlands, Yahaira returned to Aruba in 2002 to pursue her career as a Legal Specialist. Still art remained one of her true passions and in her free time she started painting more often using mainly acrylics as a creative medium and experimenting with different styles. Yahaira's creative spirit sparks out the best through Abstract Expression and Pop Art. Most of her inspiration comes from how she feels. Colors, energy and movement play a major part in her paintings. She often chooses bold colors as well as daring color combinations and loves to use plenty layers of paint to add texture, depth and contrast to her work. Inspired by "Action painting", Yahaira uses Jackson Pollock's technique to celebrate the joy and playfulness of artistic creation. She does this by dripping, pouring and splashing acrylic paint onto a horizontal surface, since this enables her to view and paint her canvases from all angles. "Apasionada" is Yahaira's second Solo Exhibition. By combining Abstract Expressionism and Pop Art in her body of work for this exhibition, she wants to exalt different types of love and passion, through a colorful journey of creativity aiming to stimulate the mind, heart and senses of the viewer to embrace their feelings and follow their heart.








# Acrobatic Arts

#### **About Acrobatic Dance**

Acrobatic Dance, or acro as it is commonly referred to by dancers and dance professionals, is the beautiful fusion of classic dance technique and the precision and athleticism of acrobatic elements. Often defined by unique choreography, acro dancers seamlessly blend musicality, emotional expression, line and extension with acrobatic movements in a dance context.

Acro is an especially challenging style for dancers to master, as training in both dance and acrobatic elements is required. Acro

technique includes balancing, limbering, tumbling and partnering, based in flexibility, contortion and strength.



Dancers who train through Acrobatic Arts have balanced development, are stronger, more flexible and fearless. Studios that implement this program will see dancers with more skills, who have fewer accidents, and are less likely to develop chronic injuries.

# Circus Arts / Aerial Dance

#### **About Silks**

Aerial silks (also known as aerial contortion, aerial ribbons, aerial silks, aerial tissues, fabric, ribbon, or tissu, depending on personal preference) is a type of performance in which one or more artists perform aerial acrobatics while hanging from a fabric. The fabric may be hung as two pieces, or a single piece, folded to make a loop, classified as hammock silks. Performers climb the suspended fabric without the use of safety lines, and rely only on their training and skill to ensure safety. They use the fabric to wrap, suspend, fall, swing, and spiral their bodies into and out of various positions. Aerial silks may be used to fly through the air, striking poses and figures while flying. Aerial Dance is also categorized as an extreme sport.

#### **About Bungee Dancing**

Bungee Dance brings new possibilities and a new feeling of flying. Attached to a bungee sling students will jump fly and dance. Imagine being able to explore movement in an exhilarating feeling of defying gravity as a form of getting an intense full body workout. This high-intensity workshop/class has one floating weightlessly, dynamically bouncing and spinning freely into space.
